Not-for-profit foundation (NL law), born 21 October 2016

Founding fathers: 3 pioneers of the European CSIRT community

Goal is *improving - in the public interest - cyber resilience, by promoting cooperation and development of "cyber security incident management" and related matters ... promoting and facilitating research, training, education, standardization and "best practices"*.

12 July 2023 : TF-CSIRT integrated into OCF

Governance:

- Board of Directors: 4 appointed members
- Board of Commissioners: 6 members of which 3 elected
- TF-CSIRT Steering Committee: 7 elected members

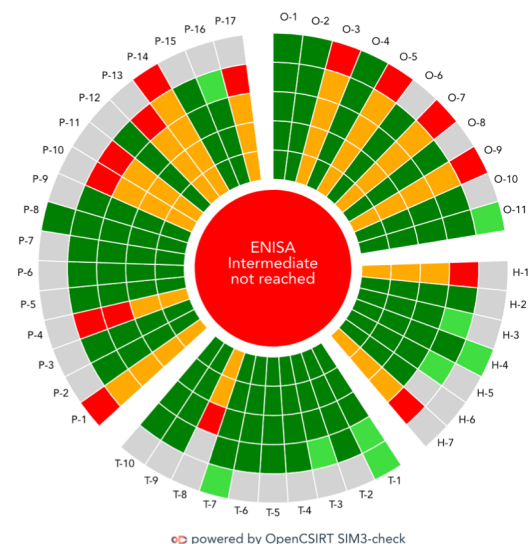


Security Incident Management Maturity Model

- For (self) assessment, membership criteria & accreditation/certification purposes
- Used all over the world now
- Free for internal and not-for-profit use
- For CSIRT/CERT, soon also for SOC, ISAC and PSIRT

Certified SIM3 Auditors

- 3-day certification training by OCF
- Auditors have to meet annual standards
- Ethics apply, complaints to OCF
- 130+ auditors worldwide, expanding

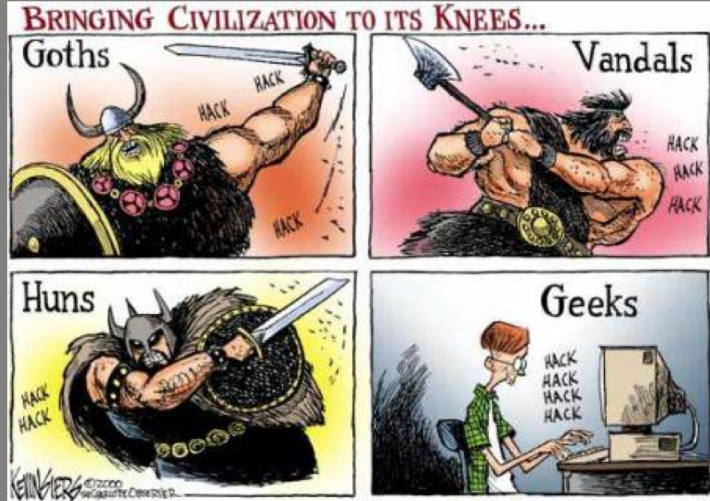

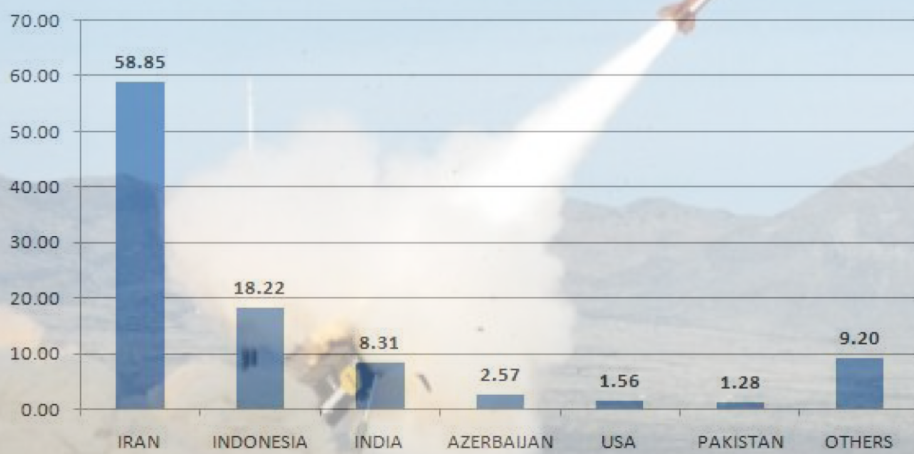

AI (i)



There's so much crap around about AI, including experts who only stare at their own navel, and entrepreneurs (a la Musk) who may be mostly interested in their own gain.

AI (ii)



Areas of concern for Geoff Hinton (starts at 8'10") :

- Taking away jobs: "In a decent society that would be great ... but the danger is that it will make the rich richer and the poor poorer. That's not AI's fault, that's how we organise society."
- "There's danger about AI making it impossible to know what's true, by having so many {perfect} fakes out there ... being swamped by these fake videos, and fake voices and fake images ..."
- Existential threat : "the chance that they get more intelligent than us, and they'll take over from us, they get control".

He also mentions the great potential benefits of AI (starts at 15'30"): "So they're going to be developed, there's no way that's going to be stopped." He pleads to put MUCH more effort into learning how to work with AI safely. (50/50 instead of 99/1)

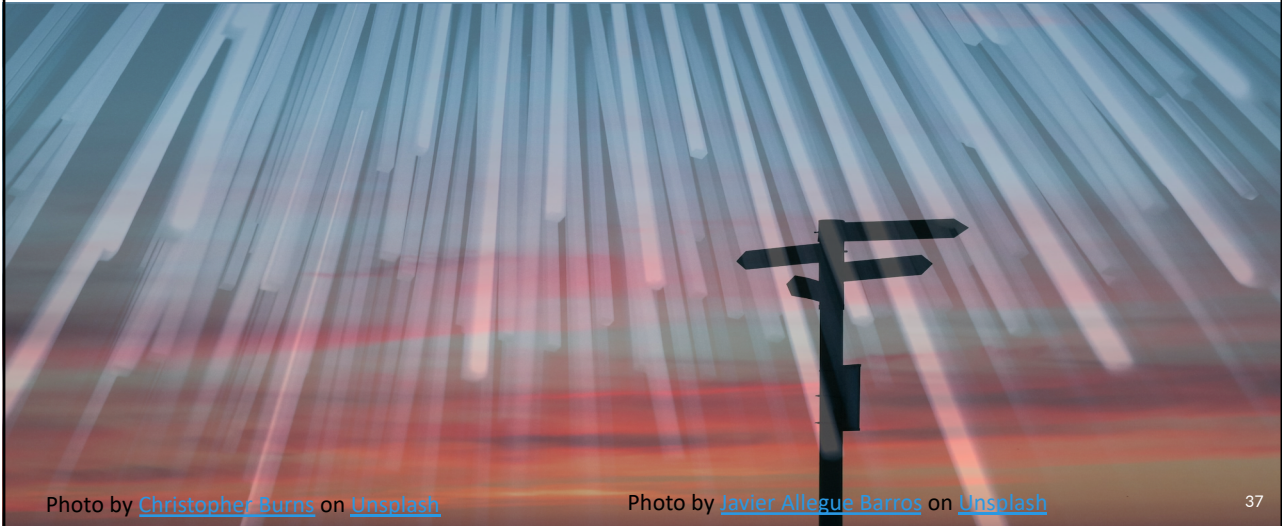

- Fasten your seat belts !




Individual protection versus logging and tapping

Economy ...



World order is unstable : Position of US\$? Economy ?

China, India et al – emerging world powers : yet internal tensions.

Ukraine war game changer ?

Middle East – always tensions, peak oil is a hoax, but oil is expendable.

Communism went under, is capitalism next, or ?

Think beyond the veil: **who** benefits ?

Infosec/CERTs : protect constituency interests first and foremost ... rising tensions influence cooperation models

- Need for **diversity** when we cooperate
- CSIRTs are frontrunners: **KEEP THAT UP**
- CSIRT community **MUST** engage with politics, cyber diplomacy etc.

Infosec/CSIRTs : conflicts of interest

- Again, **diversity** in cooperations

Interpretation of Human Rights varies wildly, but :
How do you want your kids to be treated by the world ?

Rich investors don't always score high on this scale

Inside most countries : increasing pressure on Human Rights

Must address climate & environmental threats

Infosec : with increasing importance of IT and security, we enter the field of ethics and Human Rights

- Examples Middle East, Russia, Wikileaks, Snowden,
- "The fact that a person acted pursuant to order of his Government or of a superior does not relieve him from responsibility under international law, provided a moral choice was in fact possible to him." (Nuremberg Principle IV)

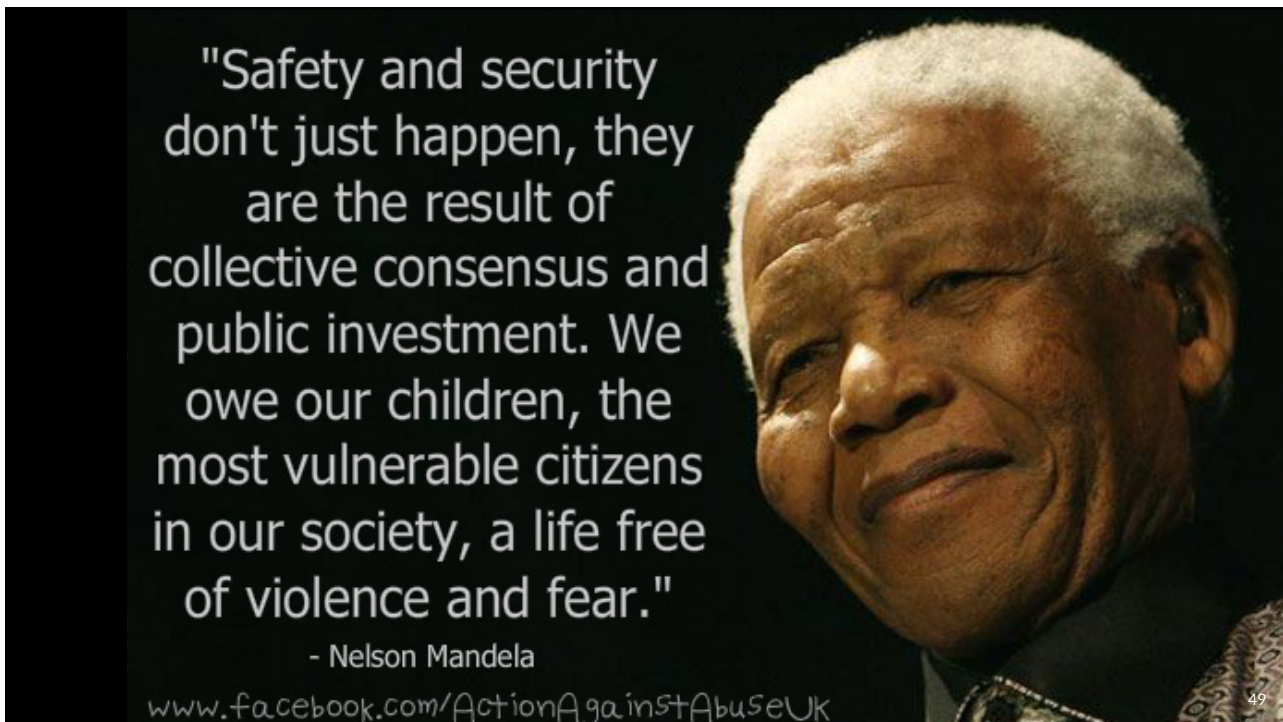

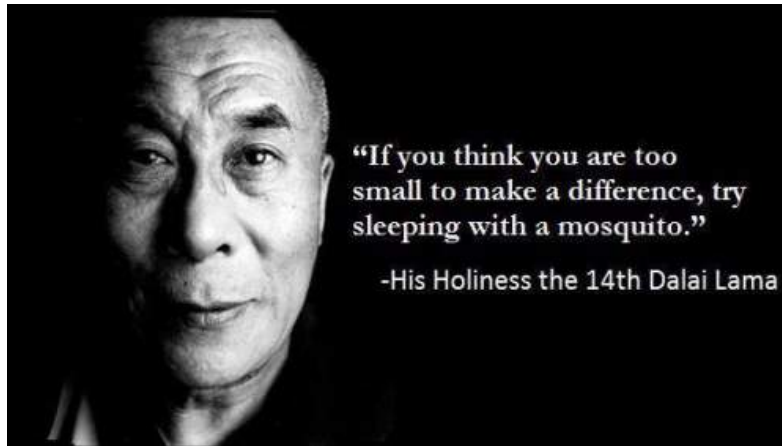
